Nature's rainbow chips

BRING NATURE HOME ACTIVITY

This activity is a great way to really explore the subtleties of nature. You can do it anywhere - in your garden or on a walk close to your home.

What you will need

 Double sided sticky tape
Colour chart (or make your own!)

All you need are some coloured pieces of card or paper. You can use anything – cut up cereal boxes, old postcards or greetings cards or even get your paints out and make your own!

We made our challenge extra tricky by using a **graduated paint chart** from a DIY shop...this really makes you notice how many different shades there are in nature! Apply a strip of **double sided sticky tape** to the front of the card and you're ready to go!

The challenge is to gather as many of nature's colours as you can. When you find the perfect match for your card, peel back the sticky tape and stick your treasure to it.



Obviously we want to leave the really special bits of nature in place. **Don't pick wildflowers they are far too precious** - but maybe you could take a photo of them next to your colour chip instead.
