This toolkit will equip you with everything you need to educate your pupils on the negative impacts that driving to school has on the environment around us, and motivate them to choose a more active method of transport.

ABOUT THE CAMPAIGN

Green Miles is a North Yorkshire County Council campaign, in partnership with Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust (YDMT) and the Local Nature Partnership (LNP), that aims to encourage secondary school pupils to choose to walk to and from school.

After conducting insight across a number of schools we know that pupils are concerned about the damaging effects pollution and climate change has on wildlife and the planet as a whole. So this campaign hopes to educate young people on the positive impact walking can have on the wider environmental issues – and what they can do to make a difference.

WHY SHOULD YOU GET INVOLVED?

POLLUTION DAMAGES OUR LANDSCAPES, CONTAMINATES WATER SYSTEMS AND ENDANGERS ANIMALS

Not forgetting that pollution causes harm to us by reducing the quality of air we breathe every day.

By launching the campaign in your school, you'll help encourage pupils to take one simple step towards reducing their carbon footprint and improving the environment they live in!







WHAT CAN PUPILS DO?

There is **one** easy thing pupils can choose to do to help reduce pollution, prevent climate change and improve the environment they live in...













THEY COULD...

- Walk to and from school every day (they might be doing this already!)
- Choose to walk one way either to or from school.
- Pick at least one day a week to walk. They could choose a day with their friends and walk together.
- If they live far away, they could ask their parent/carer to drop them off half way so they can walk the rest. They might want to meet at a friend's house if they live nearer.

SAMPLE INFORMATION FOR WEBSITE OR SCHOOL INTRANET

GREEN MILES TRACKER [PUPIL ACTIVITY]

This chart can be used by each pupil in your class to help reinforce the benefits of choosing to walk to school.

- Give each pupil a copy of the Green Miles Tracker to record how they travel to and from school.
- Ask them to record their journeys twice a day for four weeks. At the end of the exercise, the pupils with other 120 points can be in with a chance of winning a prize.

The chart is supplied as weekly sheets, meaning one for each week. Each pupil should be given 4 to complete the activity.





The Green Miles Tracker is sized A3 and can be printed if preferred. This can be found in the supporting 'Assets Pack'.

SAMPLE SOCIAL MEDIA MESSAGES

TO BE POSTED OUT VIA YOUR SCHOOL'S SOCIAL MEDIA CHANNELS.



GRAPHICS FOR PLASMA SCREENS AND TVS


These plasma screens will display various key messages for the campaign which address the environmental issues your students said they care about.

Branded headers to use on your school website or emails when communicating campaign messages.


Just insert the image to the top of your webpage or email.

GRAPHICS FOR WAYFINDING REMINDERS

A branded sticker design to use to promote the campaign on the ground. These should be used as reminders and to encourage pupils to walk to school.

It is recommended to place around different areas of the school that pupils regularly pass through on their journey to and from school.

To get these printed we advise liasing directly with a printer to discuss window stickers and easy peel options.
